



How to Properly Dispose of Unused Medications

The Nashua River Watershed Association (NRWA) encourages everyone to properly dispose of unused medications, including pet medications, by taking them to the permanent drop box located at the [police station](#). This service is free and anonymous. Just cross out your name and any identifying information on the label before dropping them in the box. Proper disposal prevents these pharmaceuticals from contaminating our drinking and groundwater supplies, which is a risk if they are flushed or thrown into the trash. It also prevents them from being stolen or misused. Proper disposal will benefit humans, fish and other aquatic life.
