2011-2012 Gardner Refuse Collection

The City supplied 48 gallon toter to each household. Any extra trash must be in the City PAYT bags available at the following places: Stop & Shop and Hannaford Supermarkets, Agway, and Aubuchon Hardware Store.

- ▲ Free recycling of bottles, cans, milk cartons, juice boxes and plastic containers in the recycling toter.
- ▲ Free recycling of paper, paperboard and cardboard flattened and cut to fit within the toter.
- ▲ Free yard waste collection as per enclosed schedule, Christmas tree collection in January.

Remember
You can put your toters out for collection up to 24 hours before collection, and you must bring them in within 12 hours after collection.

Did you know...?

- Massachusetts prohibits the disposal of the following items:
- Paper and cardboard
 - Bottles and cans
 - Leaves and yard waste
 - Car batteries
 - TVs and computers
 - Large home appliances
- Be sure to keep these items out of your trash.

For all Residents with Municipal Trash Collection

Toter Do's & Don'ts

- ▲ Do place your toter at the curb with the serial number facing the street
- ▲ Do leave 3 feet between your trash and recycling toters
- ▲ Do take your toter in within 12 hours after collection
- ⊘ Don't Park in front of your toter or place it behind an obstacle- pole, mailbox etc.
- ⊘ Don't put your toter out more than 24 hours in advance



EASY!

Single Stream Recycling is easy!
Place ALL recycling together in toter



- ▲ Newspaper with inserts ▲ Magazines, catalogs, paperback & phone books
- ▲ Junk mail & office paper ▲ Paper bags, paperboard, e.g. cereal box
- ▲ Corrugated cardboard, cut to 2'x2' max ▲ Glass bottles/jars (all colors)
- ▲ Tin, steel, aluminum food cans & lids, aluminum foil, empty aerosol cans
- ▲ Plastic containers labeled ♻️-♻️. ▲ Milk & juice cartons, drink boxes



- ▲ No plastic bags ▲ No Styrofoam
- ▲ No wet or soiled paper
- ▲ No cans containing hazardous material
- ▲ No light bulbs, window glass, auto glass, dishes, glasses, Pyrex
- ▲ pizza boxes

Drop-Off Recycling, Yard Waste, Trash, Composting, and Construction Debris

The following items ARE NOT picked up curbside and may be brought to the recycling center on 744 West Street (Rt 68) between the hours of 9am and 3pm Wed thru Fri and 7am to 1 pm on Saturdays. Acceptable items WITHOUT a cost include used motor oil, scrap metal, auto batteries, Ni-Cad rechargeable batteries, Lithium batteries, hearing aid and small "button" batteries and paint-see surplus paint brochure for additional information on paint. Please note that Styrofoam and most plastics are recyclable at the Transfer Station.

Items WITH a cost include major appliances such as stoves, dryers, washers, dishwashers, small engines (mowers, etc.), refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, water bubblers, TV's, and computers at \$15.00 ea.; upholstered furniture, mattresses, and boxsprings at \$15 ea.; wood furniture at \$10 ea.; fluorescent bulbs at \$1.00 ea.; and tires at \$5 ea. Trash and construction waste charged per load.

Recycling Collection Schedule

Recycling bins are collected every other week on your regular trash collection day. All A Weeks are collected during weeks highlighted in BLUE on calendar (on other side). All B Weeks are collected during weeks highlighted in GREEN. Find your street on the street listing to see if you are A or B Week.

Please place at curbside on your scheduled day.

Holiday Schedule

Whenever a scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day. Friday's collection will be on Saturday. Holidays are marked.

Note – Monday Holidays do not Affect Trash, Recycling or Yard Waste Collection.

Yard Waste Collection



▲ Leaves, grass and all other easily raked material. Place in paper yard waste, open barrels or boxes.

▲ Branches less than 2" dia., not to exceed 3' long – bundled

▲ Yard waste collection: first full collection week (Tues-Friday) of July, Aug., Sept., Oct., Nov., April, May & June that does not contain a holiday. Christmas tree and yard waste pickup in Jan.

Second yard waste collection in November!
