Cowee Pond Dam

DPW would like to bring the conservation commissions attention to cowee pond dam for vegetative maintenance.

There is an area that they wish to cut back (glossy buckthorn and other shrubs and dense vegetation encroaching on spillway) and trim back the corner area near the posts, remove dead falls from a cart road that leads up to the dam where they must routinely remove beaver debris and clearing the road for an ATV side is the alternative to walking debris out by hand.
