How To Apply for Scholarships:

- Fill out the checklist to see which scholarships you are eligible to apply for
- Address a letter to: Dear Scholarship committee, then type in your letter the information requested (basically your purpose in attending college and why you need financial help)
 - Please have your letters or essays proofread by an English teacher for correct grammar and spelling.
- Essay-start with your college essay and edit if needed. See your senior English teacher for help
- Complete an activities resume
- Print a copy of your Transcript
- Fill out the applications
 - Each Special Application you qualify for (some specific essays may be required)
 - 1 Standard Application (leave Scholarship Name Line Blank)
 - Make sure both student and parent sign the application
 - Financial information on the scholarship application should be completed after you have decided where you are attending and financial aid packages have been received. Student's financial data needs to be as accurate as possible. If you are deciding between schools, list both schools.
- Make copies of your letter, activities resume and transcript based on the numbers you put on the following forms:
- Some may need a Copy of your Parent tax forms (you can black out the SS#). Cannot be W2 forms.
- Please staple all applications. (no paperclips or envelopes)
- Mail completed scholarship packets in labeled bins in the Guidance office before the due date.

- Some scholarships are not awarded until the 2nd semester of college. Please contact the person on the award letter for payment. Some scholarships may require college transcripts or 2nd semester tuition bills to be sent before receiving 2nd semester payments. Contact information for payment and where thank you notes can be sent, will be included in the scholarship packet given after the senior awards ceremony.
- Some scholarships are renewable, so keeping the letters will help determine who you contact to re-apply.
- Checks paid from the City will be available in the summer. Second semester scholarship checks are available in January.
- Distribution of payment is not in our control. A suggestion: Please plan on applying scholarship funds to 2nd semester.
- Some scholarship checks are sent directly to the college or university.
- Please make sure you notify the guidance office of any school changes after graduation. Checks could be mailed to the wrong college or university.
