Overdose Prevention Resources

First responders in your municipality can receive free training on preventing, recognizing, and responding to overdoses. Training includes rescue breathing and how to use Naloxone (Narcan). Your city or town may also purchase Narcan for municipal first responder agencies at a discounted rate.

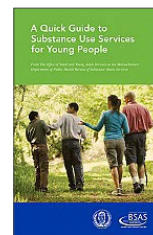
